


SALAR & LAGUNAS

Brief Description of the Tour

The classic tour to see the spectacular Uyuni salt flat, the beautiful colored lagoons and the incomparable landscapes of Los Lípez. The tour starts in Tupiza and ends in Uyuni. It can be done in the opposite direction: Uyuni to Tupiza.

Descriptive	Lodging
<p>DAY 1: Tupiza – Quetena (Reserva Eduardo Avaroa) From Tupiza, you ascend through the beautiful landscape of Quebrada de Palala towards El Sillar. Continue towards the mining areas of Nazarenito until you reach the town of San Antonio de Lipez, a few kilometers away you will take a walk through the ruins of the old colonial town, now called GHOST TOWN.</p> <p>We will continue the journey diverting the road to CIUDAD ENCANTO, a mysterious and magical plain where geological formations of volcanic lava and dozens of natural sculptures emerge, we will continue along one of the highest mountain roads in the country towards Torreón and Laguna Morejón, then we will enter the Eduardo Avaroa National Park until reaching Quetena. Arrival approx. 5:30 p.m., at 8:00 p.m. dinner and overnight.</p>	<p>Basic: Basic lodging with rooms and shared bathroom for 4 to 6 people. (Included in the cost of the tour) Standard: Basic accommodation in a private double room with private bathroom. Additional cost Special: None in the region.</p>
<p>DAY 2: Quetena – Laguna Colorada Start of the excursion at 07:30 am. Bordering magnificent bofedales we will visit the lagoons and the small Salar de Chalviri, later we will visit the Hot Springs where you can enjoy a delicious bath. 20 minutes away you can visit the Salvador Dalí Desert.</p> <p>Continue the trip to the viewpoint of Laguna Verde and Laguna Blanca. These lagoons are located at the foot of the Licancabur Volcano. After lunch, the excursion continues to the Sol de Mañana Geysers, a region of intense volcanic activity. Later we continue to Laguna Colorada located at the foot of Cerro Negro, this lagoon is a sanctuary for thousands of Pink Flamingos. This day we will sleep in a lodge near the Laguna Colorada.</p>	<p>Basic: Basic lodging with rooms and shared bathroom for 4 to 6 people. <p>DAY 3: Laguna Colorada – Chuvica Departure 07:30 a.m. We will start the journey to the north to cross the Siloli Desert. The surroundings have a majestic view of colorful volcanoes and plains with large herds of vicuñas and lots of wildlife. Descending, you reach the Route of the Jewels, which are beautiful lagoons like Lag. ChiarKhota and Lag. Foul-smelling, the latter has a high sulfur content so it gives off a foul smell and is home to three varieties of flamingos.</p> <p>The trip continues towards the viewpoint of the Ollagüe Volcano 5865 m.a.s.l., until reaching the Tomasamil Volcano 5890 m.a.s.l. to then cross the Salar de Chiguana, the fourth largest salt desert in Bolivia. We will arrive at the great Salar de Uyuni where we will enjoy a majestic sunset. Overnight in Chuvica (Salt Lodge)</p>	<p>Basic: Basic lodging with rooms and shared bathroom for 4 to 6 people. <p>DAY 4: Chuvica – Gran Salar – Uyuni It leaves 05:30 hrs. You will enjoy the sunrise in the Great Salar de Uyuni and then take a walk along a beautiful trail of petrified reefs on the Inkahuasi Island or house of the Inca. After the visit to the island, the vehicle moves away from the Island towards a salt flat to look for a suitable place to take perspective photos.</p> <p>We will continue with the visit to the first Hotel de Sal (Playa Blanca), the Ojos de Sal, small family salt extraction factories where the piles of salt are found and finally the Colchani craft market, where you can buy souvenirs made of llama wool, alpaca and salt, then you go to the Train Cemetery to stroll among locomotives, irons and metals from the 18th century to finish in the city of Uyuni at 01:00 p.m. approximately.</p>	<p>Does not include this day.</p>
